On September 5th a show called „Glast“ with selected works of mine from California, Vietnam, Dubai, Norway and Algeria will be opened at Rothamel Gallery Frankfurt am Main.

After successful presentations at the Centro Cultural Banco do Brasil in Brasilia and in Rio de Janeiro the exhibition „The Tropics – views from the middle of the globe“ will come to the Martin-Gropius-Bau Berlin in an extended version.

The show which was organized by the Goethe-Institute Rio de Janeiro and the Ethnological Museum Berlin combines traditional art objects from the tropic regions of the world with works of more than 40 contemporary artists dealing with this topic.

Alfons Hug, the Curator of the exhibition and the Director of Goethe-Institute Rio de Janeiro, invited me to Brazil last year to take photographs for the exhibition project. One of the works I did there will be on view, as well as some pieces from Cambodia and Vietnam.
