Seven years ago I started to experiment for my „1 h“ project which has been essentially modified since. The project will be presented as two series of 12 images each from different places of the northern and the southern hemisphere depicting the „movement“ of the sun during an exposure time of exactly one hour.

To create these works I use the effect known as „true solarization“. Caused by extreme overexposure the image of the sun within the picture turns from white into black.

The project will be finished next year.

A selection of works from the already completed Northern Hemisphere portfolio will be part of the exhibition „VETO – CONTEMPORARY POSITIONS IN GERMAN PHOTOGRAPHY“, which will be on view at the Deichtorhallen Hamburg, Germany, from next week on.

The work of the eight participating artists reflects the conditions of contemporary photography, each with a different approach.
